Safety guidelines

Important safety guidelines for visitors entering Grindavík;

- Evacuation will be announced via emergency alarms and text message.
- 2. In the event of an evacuation, leave the area immediately and follow the escape route signs.
- 3. Children are the responsibility of adults and must never leave their sight.
- 4. Stay out of fenced areas.
- 5. Avoid walking on the lava field, as it is unstable, very sharp and can be dangerously hot.
- 6. Do not enter private property.
- 7. Be cautious about stopping on the roadside on your way to town, as this increases the risk of serious traffic accidents.
- 8. Walking outside the town is strongly discouraged, fault movements and sinkholes can open without warning. The fall can be fatal.









What to do if you hear the emercency alarm?

If the emergency alarm sounds, leave the town immediately using the nearest marked escape route and drive safely.

Security and emergency personnel are present in the town and will assist people.

Please note that the evacuation alarm is tested on the last Wednesday of every month at 11:00.

General information

Frequent and intense seismic activity on the Revkianes Peninsula has been steadily increasing in recent years. This heightened activity has triggered both earthquakes and volcanic eruptions, with the town of Grindavík being evacuated due to the elevated risk in the area. During this time, the town sustained significant damage, including deep cracks forming both within and around the town, as well as severe damage to buildings. In January 2024, three houses in Grindavík were destroyed by flowing lava.

The town was reopened to the public in 2024. The situation will continue to be closely monitored, and if necessary, Grindavík may be evacuated again.

To enhance safety in Grindavík, several countermeasures have been put in place. Cracks have been sealed or fenced off. Stress tests have been conducted at repaired sites. Safety and warning signs have been placed around town and it is important to follow their instructions at all times.
